Membership Policy & Procedures

The purpose of the Denver Broncos Quarterback Club is to promote and support the NFL Denver Broncos organization by scheduling seasonal monthly events with a guest speaker from the Broncos organization, player alumni, local sports analysts and other individuals of interest to the Club membership.

A membership is a Family Membership defined as including persons in the Member's immediate and extended family. Persons outside of the Member's family may not be included.

Monthly Meetings Admission

Monthly meetings are provided to the members at a current admission of \$20 per person. This payment meets the Club's contractual obligations with the event provider. A dinner will be provided. A Member must RSVP with the number of persons attending prior to the event.

- The admission must be paid by each Member and their guest regardless of the time of arrival to the meeting.
- If a Member makes an RSVP reservation and then does not attend the meeting, the admission cost for the number of persons reserved is still due and payment must be made to the Club prior to the next meeting. The Club is obligated to still pay for your reservation.
- If a Member makes an RSVP and does not participate in the meal. The admission cost is still due and payable upon arrival.

Guests

Members are encouraged to bring a guest to a meeting to introduce them to the Club and promote Club growth. To eliminate any misuse of the membership process and to encourage growth of the Club membership, the following policies are required:

- A Member must include the guest in their RSVP for an event.
- The admission cost of \$20 must be paid on arrival by the guest or sponsoring Member.
- A guest may attend one time as a guest. If the guest wishes to continue to enjoy the events of the Club, they must complete a Membership Application and pay the membership fee.
- NEW! A referral reward of one (1) free admission will be given to a Member at the next meeting when
 their guest or other referral becomes a Member by completing a Membership Application and paying the
 membership fee.

Member Code of Conduct
